**ORDER SCHEDULING EMERGENCY HEARING
ON SHORTENED NOTICE TO CONSIDER DEBTOR'S "FIRST DAY MOTIONS"**

Upon the following motions filed on March 18, 2015, by Federation Employment Guidance Service, Inc d/b/a/ FEES (the "**Debtor**"), and related requests for relief therein (collectively, the "**First Day Motions**"):

- Debtor's Motion for Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Authorizing Debtor (A) to Obtain Post-Petition Secured, Superpriority Financing Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Sections 105, 361, 362, 363 and 364 and (B) to Utilize Cash Collateral Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 363; (II) Granting Adequate Protection to Pre-Petition Secured Creditors Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Sections 361, 362, 363 and 364; and (III) Scheduling a Final Hearing Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rules 4001(B) and 4001(C) [Docket No. 15];

and upon the *Amended Affidavit of Kristin Woodlock Pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule 1007-4 and in Support of First Day Motions* (the "**1007 Affidavit**") [Docket No. 16]; and after due deliberation and good and sufficient cause appearing on shortening notice of hearing on the First Day Motions required under the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, and the Local Rules; it is hereby

ORDERED, that a hearing will be held before the Honorable Robert E. Grossman, United States Bankruptcy Judge of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the

Eastern District of New York, in Courtroom 860 at the Alfonse M. D'Amato Federal Courthouse, 290 Federal Plaza, Central Islip, New York 11722 on March 20, 2015 at 11 a.m., or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard (the "**Hearing**"), to consider the First Day Motions; and it is further

ORDERED, that within one (1) business day of entry of this Order, copies of this Order, the 1007 Affidavit, the respective First Day Motions (with all Exhibits), and Notice of Hearing shall be served by electronic mail or overnight mail service upon the parties set forth in the respective notice provision of the First Day Motions; and it is further

ORDERED, that responses or objections, if any, to the relief sought in the First Day Motions, may be raised at the Hearing; and it is further

ORDERED, that in accordance with Bankruptcy Rules 9014 and 6006, and Local Rule 9077-1(c), notice of the Hearing is shortened and shall be deemed sufficient and adequate if served in accordance with the terms of the Order.
