**ORDER GRANTING SEVENTH INTERIM FEE  
APPLICATION OF BGBC PARTNERS, LLP FOR COMPENSATION  
FOR SERVICES RENDERED AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES  
INCURRED AS ACCOUNTANTS AND FINANCIAL ADVISORS FOR THE  
TRUSTEE FOR THE PERIOD NOVEMBER 1, 2020 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2021**

This matter came before the Court on the *Seventh Interim Fee Application of BGBC Partners, LLP for Compensation for Services Rendered and Reimbursement of Expenses Incurred as Accountants and Financial Advisors for the Trustee for the Period November 1, 2020 through October 31, 2021* (the “Application”) [Doc 4514], filed by BGBC Partners, LLP (“BGBC”), accountants and financial advisors to Deborah J. Caruso, the chapter 7 trustee in this case (the “Trustee”). In the Application, BGBC requests (a) allowance of interim compensation

for professional services performed by BGBC for the period commencing November 1, 2020 through and including October 31, 2021 (the “Current Compensation Period”) in the amount of \$289,829.50, (b) reimbursement of BGBC’s actual and necessary expenses in the amount of \$21,830.17 incurred during the Current Compensation Period, and (c) authorizing the Trustee to pay BGBC the sum of \$57,965.90 for the unpaid Holdback<sup>2</sup> incurred during the Current Compensation Period.

The Court, having considered the Application and having convened a hearing on December 15, 2021 and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, determines that the Application should be, and hereby is GRANTED. Accordingly,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

1. The Application is GRANTED in its entirety.
2. BGBC’s compensation for professional services rendered during the Current Compensation Period is allowed on an interim basis in the amount of \$289,829.50.
3. Reimbursement of BGBC’s expenses incurred during the Current Compensation Period is allowed on an interim basis in the amount of \$21,830.17.
4. The Trustee is authorized to pay BGBC the sum of \$57,965.90 for the unpaid Holdback incurred during the Current Compensation Period, which shall be paid from the ITT bankruptcy estate.
5. The compensation and reimbursement of expenses awarded in this Order shall be interim and subject to final approval pursuant to section 330(a)(5) of the Bankruptcy Code.
6. The allowance of interim compensation and reimbursement of expenses pursuant to this Order is without prejudice to BGBC’s right to seek additional compensation for services

performed and expenses incurred during the Current Compensation Period, which were not processed at the time of the Application.
