**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO SHORTEN  
NOTICE ON THE TRUSTEE’S APPLICATION TO  
EMPLOY RUST CONSULTING/OMNI BANKRUPTCY AS CLAIMS AND  
NOTICING AGENT EFFECTIVE *NUNC PRO TUNC* AS OF SEPTEMBER 16, 2016**

This matter is before the Court on the *Motion to Shorten Notice on the Trustee’s Application to Employ Rust Consulting/Omni Bankruptcy as Claims and Noticing Agent Effective Nunc Pro Tunc as of September 16, 2016* (the “Notice Motion”) [Doc 26], filed by Deborah J. Caruso, the duly appointed, qualified and acting chapter 7 trustee in the above-referenced bankruptcy case (the “Trustee”). In the Notice Motion, the Trustee requests entry of an Order, pursuant to Rule 9006(c) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the “Bankruptcy Rules”) and Local Rule B-9006-1, shortening the notice period on the *Trustee’s Application to Employ Rust Consulting/Omni Bankruptcy as Claims and Noticing Agent Effective Nunc Pro Tunc as of September 16, 2016* (the “Rust Omni Employment Application”)

to seven (7) days and provide that in the event no objections are filed, an order approving the Rust Omni Employment Application will be issued without hearing.

The Court, having considered the Notice Motion and otherwise duly advised, determines that the Notice Motion should be, and hereby is GRANTED. Accordingly,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

1. The Notice Motion is GRANTED in its entirety.
2. The notice period with respect to the Rust Omni Employment Application is hereby shortened to seven (7) days.
3. Any objection to the Rust Omni Employment Application must be in writing and filed with the Bankruptcy Clerk by no later than **October 3, 2016**. Those not required or not permitted to file electronically must deliver any objection by U.S. mail, courier, overnight/express mail or in person at:

The objecting party must also serve a copy of the written objection upon the Trustee's counsel, Meredith R. Theisen, at Rubin & Levin, P.C., 135 N. Pennsylvania Street, Suite 1400, Indianapolis, IN 46204. **If an objection is NOT timely filed, the requested relief may be granted without a hearing.**

4. Only in the event an objection to the Rust Omni Employment Application is timely filed, a hearing on the Rust Omni Employment Application and such objection will be conducted on **October 4, 2016** at **10:00 a.m.** in Room 325 of the United States Courthouse, 46 East Ohio Street, Indianapolis, IN 46204.
