The responding party must also serve a copy of the written response upon the Trustee’s counsel, at Counsel for Trustee Deborah J. Caruso, Rubin & Levin, P.C., 135 N. Pennsylvania Street, Suite 1400, Indianapolis, IN 46204 (mtheisen@rubin-levin.net). **If a response is NOT timely filed, the requested relief may be granted without a hearing.**

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that in the event a response to the above-referenced Objection is timely filed, a telephonic hearing will be conducted on **June 23, 2021** at **1:30 p.m.** (prevailing Eastern time). Interested parties may participate at the hearing by conference call by calling 1-888-273-3658, passcode 6349352#.
