**ORDER GRANTING FIFTH INTERIM
APPLICATION OF ROBINS KAPLAN LLP FOR REIMBURSEMENT
OF EXPENSES INCURRED AS LITIGATION CO-COUNSEL FOR THE
TRUSTEE FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2021 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2021**

This matter came before the Court on the *Fifth Interim Application of Robins Kaplan LLP for Reimbursement of Expenses Incurred as Litigation Co-Counsel for the Trustee for the Period of July 1, 2021 through October 31, 2021* (the “Application”)² [Doc 4527], filed by Robins Kaplan, litigation co-counsel to the Trustee with respect to the D&O Claims. In the Application, Robins Kaplan requests interim approval of reimbursement of Robins Kaplan’s actual and

necessary expenses in the amount of \$28,098.04 incurred during the Current Reimbursement Period and authorizing the Trustee to pay Robins Kaplan such amount.

The Court, having considered the Application and having convened a hearing on December 15, 2021 and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, determines the Application should be, and hereby is GRANTED. Accordingly,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

1. The Application is GRANTED in its entirety.
2. Reimbursement of Robins Kaplan's expenses incurred during the Current Reimbursement Period is allowed on an interim basis in the amount of \$28,098.04.
3. The Trustee is authorized to pay Robins Kaplan the sum of \$28,098.04, which shall be paid from the ITT bankruptcy estate.
4. The reimbursement of expenses awarded in this Order shall be interim and subject to final approval pursuant to section 330(a)(5) of the Bankruptcy Code.
5. The allowance of interim reimbursement of expenses pursuant to this Order is without prejudice to Robins Kaplan's right to seek additional reimbursement for services performed and expenses incurred during the Current Reimbursement Period, which were not processed at the time of the Application.
