**ORDER GRANTING FIRST
INTERIM FEE APPLICATION OF TRUSTEE FOR
COMPENSATION RELATED TO THE INTERIM DISTRIBUTION
IN THE DANIEL WEBSTER COLLEGE, INC. BANKRUPTCY CASE**

This matter came before the Court on the *First Interim Fee Application of Trustee for Compensation Related to the Interim Distribution in the Daniel Webster College, Inc. Bankruptcy Case* (the “Application”) [Doc 4506], filed by Deborah J. Caruso, the chapter 7 trustee in this case (the “Trustee”). In the Application, the Trustee requests allowance of interim compensation for her statutory fee in the amount of \$378,027.77 in connection with the interim distribution in the DWC² bankruptcy case.

The Court, having considered the Application and having convened a hearing on November 17, 2021 and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, determines the Application should be, and hereby is GRANTED. Accordingly,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

1. The Application is GRANTED in its entirety.
2. The Trustee's compensation for her statutory fee in connection with the interim distribution in the DWC bankruptcy case is allowed on an interim basis in the amount of \$378,027.77.
3. The Trustee is authorized to pay herself the total sum of \$378,027.77, representing the Trustee's allowed interim compensation in connection with the interim distribution in the DWC bankruptcy case, and shall be paid by the DWC bankruptcy estate.
4. The compensation awarded in this Order shall be interim and subject to final approval.
