**ORDER SUSTAINING DISTRIBUTION TRUSTEE'S OMNIBUS OBJECTION  
TO PREPETITION WAGE CLAIMS LISTED ON DEBTORS' BANKRUPTCY  
SCHEDULES**

**ON THIS DATE** the Court considered *The Distribution Trustee's Omnibus Objection to Prepetition Wage Claims Listed on Debtors' Bankruptcy Schedules* [Docket No. 1735] (the "**Objection**") filed by GlassRatner Advisory & Capital Group, LLC, as Trustee for the 4 West Distribution Trust (the "**Trustee**" of the "**Distribution Trust**") in the above-captioned case. The Court finds that the Objection contains proof sufficient to overcome the presumption of validity imposed by Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3001(f) as to the claims identified on the attached Exhibit A (the "**Claims**"), and was properly served pursuant to the Federal and Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure. The Court finds that just cause exists to grant the relief requested in the Objection.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the Objection is **SUSTAINED** and that the Claims set forth on Exhibit A are **DISALLOWED** and stricken from the Debtor's Schedules.
