**STIPULATION TO EXTEND TIME TO
RESPOND TO APPELLANTS' OPENING BRIEF ON APPEAL AND
REPLY TO APPELLEES' ANSWERING BRIEF**

WHEREAS, counsel for Appellees wrote Appellants seeking a one-week extension of the existing briefing schedule as a professional courtesy (one week extension for Appellees to file their response brief and one week extension for Appellants' reply);

WHEREAS, Appellants conveyed that they will not oppose Appellees' request for a professional courtesy on the understanding that Appellees will not assert that Appellants' non-opposition to Appellees' motion for this additional time prejudices Appellants' position on the merits of the appeal in any way.

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by the undersigned counsel for Appellants Century Indemnity Company, as successor to CCI Insurance Company, as successor to Insurance Company of North America and Indemnity Insurance Company of North America, Westchester Fire Insurance Company and Westchester Surplus Lines Insurance Company, and Appellees Boy Scouts of America, Delaware BSA, LLC, and Sidley Austin LLP, subject to approval by the Court, that:

1. The deadline by which Appellees shall respond to Appellants' Opening Brief on Appeal will be extended to October 7, 2020;
2. The deadline by which Appellants shall reply to Appellees' response will be extended to October 21, 2020; and
3. Appellees will not assert that Appellants' non-opposition to their motion for additional time prejudices Appellants' position on the merits of the appeal in any way.
