**ORDER SETTING BRIEFING SCHEDULE REGARDING THE KHAN PARTIES'  
REQUEST THAT THE COURT'S MEMORANDUM OPINION (ECF #244) REMAIN  
UNDER SEAL**

This matter came before the Court upon the Khan Parties'<sup>1</sup> request that this Court's *Memorandum Opinion on Objection to the Khan Parties' Claims (ECF #153)* entered on October 4, 2021 (ECF #244) (the "Opinion") remain under seal. In preparation for the Trial, the Parties submitted most of their exhibits under seal due to the confidentiality designations by both Parties.

After the Trial, the Court advised the Parties that it would initially enter its Opinion under seal and directed the Parties to advise the Court whether the Opinion needs to stay under seal and if so, under what time frame. The Khan Parties requested that the Opinion remain under seal, while Cinemex has advised that neither the Opinion nor the exhibits need to remain under seal. The Court having determined that it is appropriate to schedule deadlines in order to expedite and facilitate this matter, it is hereby,

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. The Khan Parties shall file a memorandum of law no later than October 19, 2021, not to exceed five pages, that supports their request that the Opinion and all submitted exhibits remain under seal.
2. Cinemex shall file a response, not to exceed five pages, no later than seven days after the Khan Parties file their memorandum, addressing whether the Opinion and exhibits can be unsealed over the objection of the Khan Parties.
3. If the Khan Parties fail to file their memorandum by October 19, 2021, on October 20, 2021, the Court will unseal the Opinion and exhibits submitted by the Parties.
